February 9 - 19, 2017

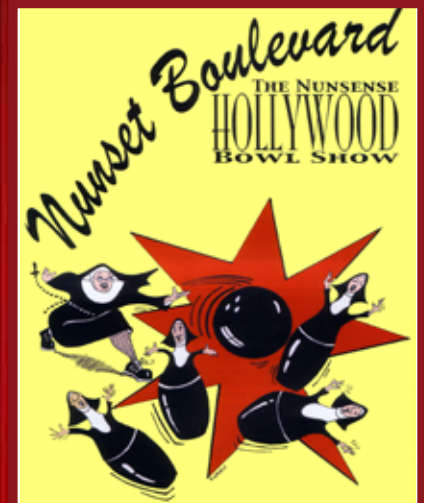
