A Message from the Artistic Director

Welcome to Main Street Players.

What do Arles Struvie, Thurston Wheelis, Aunt Pearl, Petey Fisk, Phineas Blye and Rev. Spikes have in common? They are all among the colorful residents you will meet in Greater Tuna, the third smallest town in Texas.

This hilarious show is the first in a series of four comedic plays by Jason Williams, Joe Sears and Ed Howard. It is followed by *A Tuna Christmas*, *Red White and Tuna* and *Tuna Does Vegas*. Each show is set in Tuna, TX where the Lion's Club is too liberal and Patsy Cline never dies.

This laugh out loud comment on small-town, Southern life and attitudes is the darkest in tone of all the four Tuna satires. While some might take offence during the show, it is not intended to be malicious and single out just one group.....it takes a shot at almost everyone. The play is notable in that two men play the entire cast of over twenty eccentric characters, men, women, and children. They also play animals.

Greater Tuna debuted in Austin, TX in 1981, and had it's off Broadway premier in 1982, where it played for over a year. This delightful quick-change site gag comedy soon became the most produced show in the country.

What began as a simple party skit by creators, Sears, Williams and Howard, almost 35 years ago, was parlayed into a critically acclaimed production which has entertained audience across the county ever since..




MARIAN SORENSEN (Production Manager)
