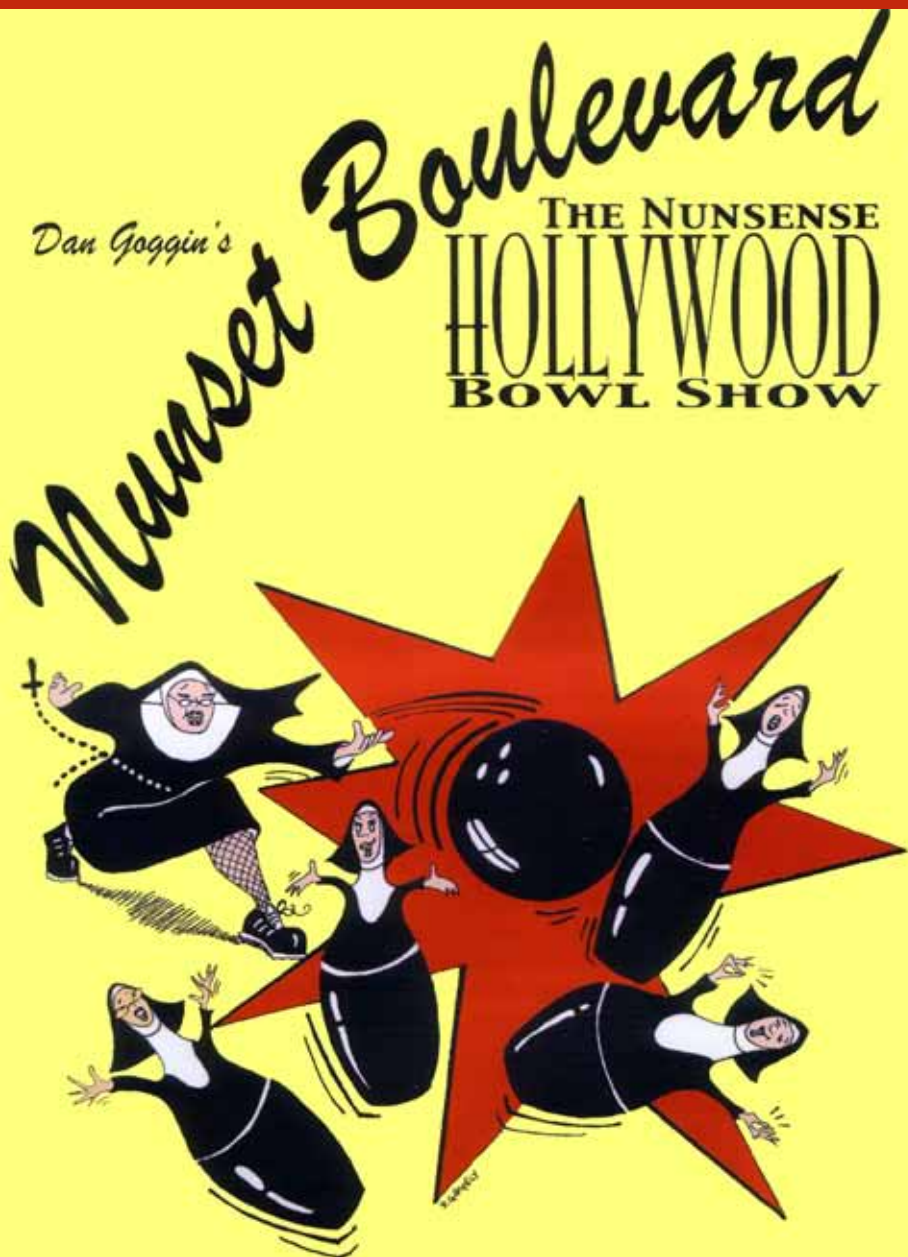

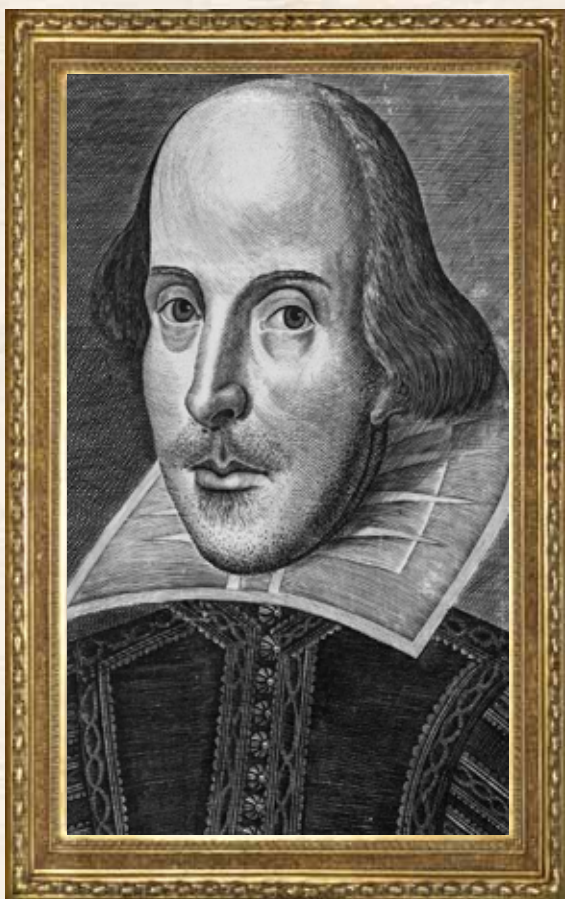

**NORMA RICHARDSON (Director)** has been involved with theatre for most of her life and has appeared on a number of Atlanta stages among others. With Main Street, her credits include: *Inherit the Wind, Titanic, The Musical, Tuesday's With Morrie, Every Christmas Story Ever Told (and Then Some), Mama Won't Fly, Our Town,* and on stage productions include; *Southern Comforts, Driving*

*Miss Daisy, Love Letters, The Little Foxes, The Guys, Steel Magnolias, Grace & Glorie, and Same Time Next Year.* Her career in television began with Turner Broadcasting/CNN. After leaving Turner, she was an Executive Vice President with Primerica and General Manager for their corporate television production department for over 20 years. She is a native of Griffin, Georgia and is the Founding Artistic Director of Main Street Players.



**JENNA SNIDEMILLER (Assistant Director)** last appeared as Shelia in the *Boys Next Door* and Mrs. Krebs in *Inherit the Wind*. Previous roles include: Miss Maudie in *To Kill A Mockingbird*, Chick Boyle in *Crimes of the Heart*, Thelma in *The Trip to Bountiful* and multiple roles in *Dashing Through the Snow*. 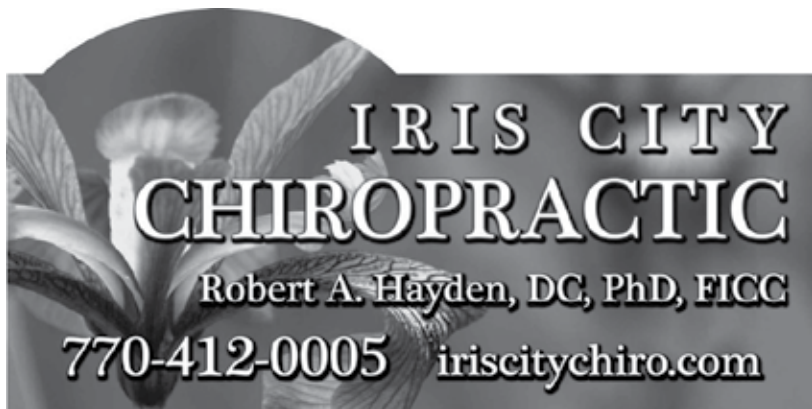

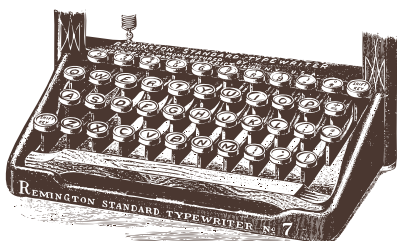

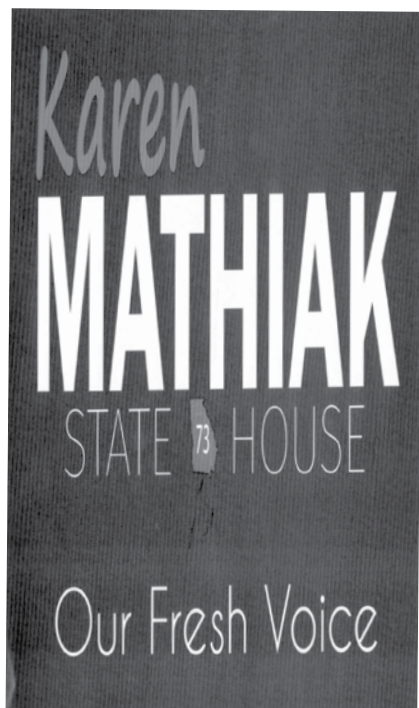
