Tammy has also directed for Fayette Community Theatre, Inc., Fayette Coweta Family Theatre, Inc., Coram Deo Classical School, Twilight Theatre, Southside Theatre and The Front Porch Players. She is currently the Artistic Director of A Company of Friends Educational Productions. She is a MAT Award Winner for Directing and is presently registered with Georgia Council for the Arts as a touring/teaching artist. **CARLA CLOUD (Marlafaye Mosley)** is thrilled to be making her stage debut with Main Street Players. Originally from the Atlanta area, she has spent most of her adult life just over the state line in South Carolina. Having appeared on many different stages over the last 40 years, her most favorite role was Hilda in *Hilda's Yard*. In addition to theater, Carla has experience in all areas of media including film, TV, and VO. She was the lead female in the faith-based film, *Waiting for Butterflies* set and filmed in Aiken, SC. She's also taught children's theater and is a member of American Immersion Theatre and A Company of Friends. **KRISTIN MOYE (Jinx Jenkins)** has sung and acted all over the United States as well as in Europe. After graduating with her Master's from Mercer University, she studied in Florence, Italy, with the Bel Canto Institute. She sang the role of Laetitia, from *The Old Maid and the Thief*, with the Triangle Opera Studios in Raleigh, NC, and performed the role of Madame Goldentrill in *The Impresario* with the Franco-American Vocal Academy. She sang Adina from *The Elixir of Love*, and The Beggar Woman from *Sweeney Todd*. Kristin worked with Sherrill Milnes and The Voice Experience in New York, and shortly after

performed in *Suor Angelica* with the Savannah Voice Festival. After her stint in Savannah, she sang *Adele* in Chattanooga, Tennessee with Opera Tennessee. She won the Pro-Mozart Scholarship of Atlanta in 2015 and due to her win, traveled to Germany to perform with the International Opera Academy and studied at the Mozarteum in Austria. Following her summer in Europe, she sang back up to Harry Connick, Jr., with the Chattanooga Symphony Chorus. She has sung selections from *Messiah* with a portion of the Atlanta Symphony Orchestra. She performed *Queen of the Night* with the German Vocal Art Institute, and she was also a selected soloist for the Casentino Vocal Festival in Poppi, Italy. Kristin was contracted to perform in *Hansel and Gretel* with Capitol City Opera's Outreach Program and made her Spivey Hall debut in February of 2019. She is excited to be performing today and looks forward to her first appearance with the Main Street Players.



**MARIAN SORENSEN (Dot Haigler)** just retired for the second time after four decades in education. Over the years she worked in Dekalb, Atlanta and the Griffin-Spalding School Systems. During her years in the Atlanta area she received theatrical training at the Alliance Theatre School at the Woodruff Arts Center. While there, she was contracted as a teacher for both their youth and adult programs. She served as the Assistant Director of the School from 1981-1986. Marian has performed and/or directed on the stages at The Alliance

**NATE BARNES (Lighting Designer/Lighting Technician)** has been the Manager at the Griffin Spalding County School System's Auditorium for the past eight years. During this time, he has worked in both audio and lighting for various performances. Nate also volunteers on the audio and visual team at Oak Hill Baptist. She is a native of Griffin, Georgia and is the Founding Artistic Director of Main Street Players.
