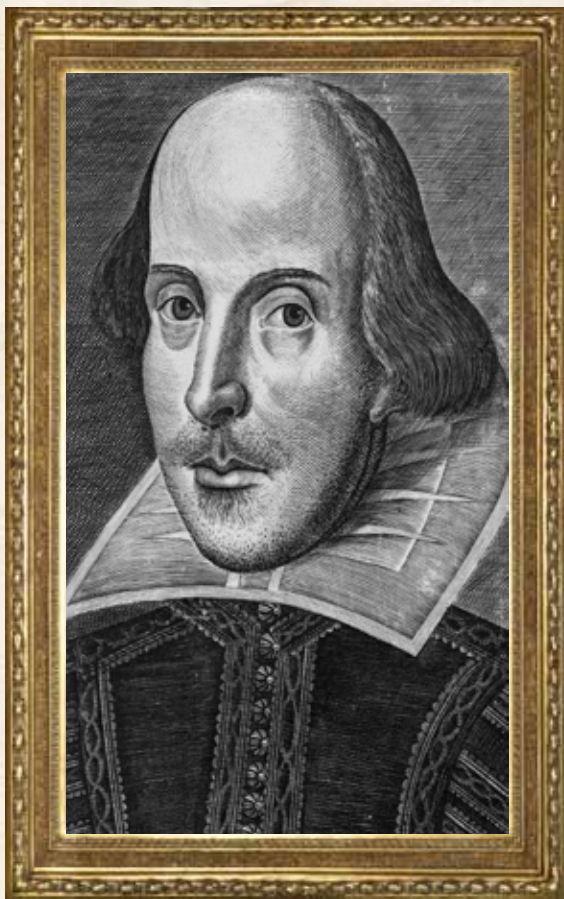
Keep in mind; these volunteer hours are in addition to the time our directors, actors, musicians, costume designers, and technical crews work on specific shows.

**JASON BROWN (Lighting Technician)** is a Griffin native who has been involved in the local arts for a few years. **BJ HUGHES (Director and Scenic Designer)** is beginning his seventh season as resident scenic designer for Main Street Players.
