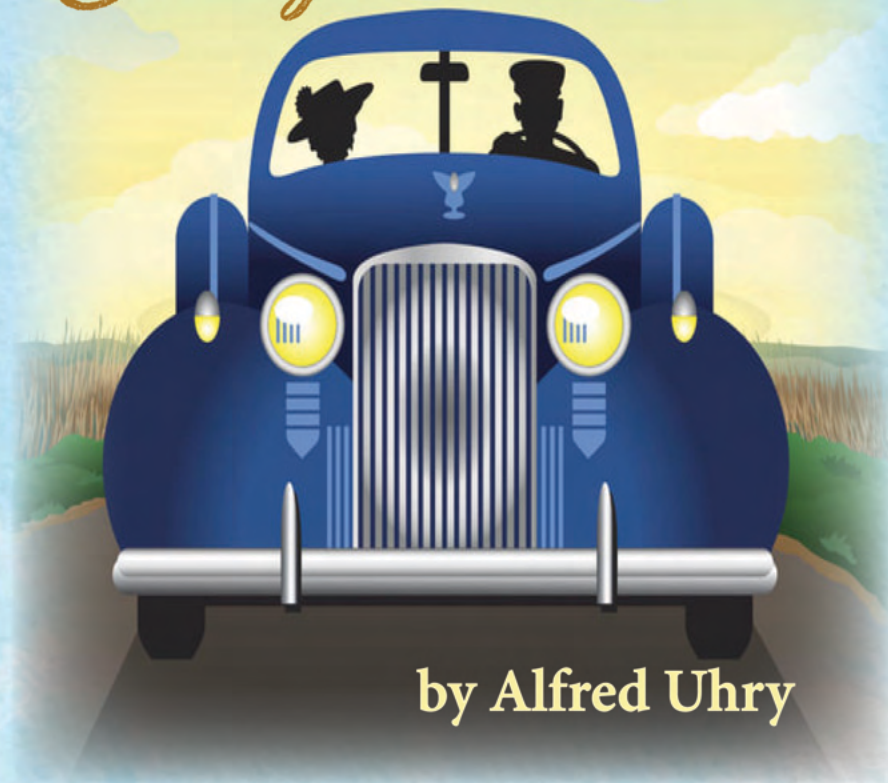



MITCHELL BRINKLEY III (Hoke Colburn) has made the stage a part of his life from a very young age. Growing up in fine art schools, he went from singing in the choir at age 7 to being a regular actor for Central High School and then Macon State College in Macon. Mitchell took to community theatre by way of Theatre Macon, where he currently sits on the board of directors. In the years he has been on the board, he has been in many shows such as *Clybourne Park*, *The Wiz*, *The Color Purple*, and *Driving Miss Daisy*. "Playing the role of Hoke was and still is an opportunity of a lifetime. Of all the shoes I've had to fill on stage, it's always an honor to walk in Hoke's!"



CHRISTOPHER GANSEL (Boolie Werthan) has delighted audiences with his portrayal of Ken De La Maze in *The Musical Comedy Murders of 1940*. Other roles at MSP include Vanya in *Vanya, Sonia, Masha and Spike*, the Man in *Now and Then*, Kris Kringle in *Another Night Before Christmas*, Watson in *Holmes and Watson* and C.C. Showers in *The Diviners*. Griffin audiences may also remember him as Gomez in Griffin Ballet Theatre's production of *The Addams Family*. Other favorite roles include: Robert Kincaid in *The Bridges of Madison County*, Edward Bloom in *Big Fish*, Peter in *Jesus Christ Superstar*, and both Freddy and Lawrence in different productions of *Dirty Rotten Scoundrels*. Chris is a two-time MAT Award nominee for his work as George Milton in *Of Mice and Men* and Dan Goodman in *Next to Normal*. He thanks the MSP family for making him one of their own.



NORMA RICHARDSON (Daisy Werthan/Artistic Director) has been involved with theatre for most of her life and has appeared on a number of Atlanta stages among others. On stage performances include: *Foxfire*, *Now and Then*, *The Wild Women of Winedale*, *Fireflies*, *The Lion in Winter*, *The Sweet Delilah Swim Club*, *Southern Comforts*, *Driving Miss Daisy*, *Love Letters*, *The Little Foxes*, *The Guys*, *Steel Magnolias*, *Grace & Glorie* (2 times), and *Same Time Next Year*. As a director her credits include: *Jacob Marley's Christmas Carol*, *Another Night Before Christmas*, *Hank Williams: Lost Highway*, *The Sweet Delilah Swim Club*, *The Mystery of Irma Vep*, *Honky Tonk Highway*, *Nunset Boulevard*, *Inherit the Wind*, *Titanic, the Musical*, *Tuesday's With Morrie*, *Every Christmas Story Ever Told (and Then Some!)* in 2015 and 2019, *Mama Won't Fly*, and *Our Town*. Her career in television began with Turner Broadcasting/CNN. After leaving Turner, she was an Executive Vice President with Primerica and General Manager for their corporate television production department for over 20 years. She is a native of Griffin, Georgia and is the Founding Artistic Director of Main Street Players.

JANICE AIKEN (Production Assistant) has helped behind the scenes on many MSP productions. Onstage performances include *War of the Worlds: The Panic Broadcast*, *A Trip to Bountiful*, *Inherit the Wind* and *To Kill a Mockingbird*. She was recognized by the GAAA Heart for the Arts as Main Street Player's Most Valuable Volunteer for the 2016-2017 season. Janice serves on our board and has been volunteering for Main Street Players since the fall of 2012. She has been invaluable to our organization and has worked the Box Office, sold concessions, ushered, trained others to usher, answered the phones, helped clean the theatre prior to openings, worked set construction, repaired props and is an integral part of our Theater for Young Audiences program.



NATE BARNES (Lighting Designer/Lighting Technician) has been the Manager at the Griffin Spalding County School System's Auditorium for the past eight years. During this time, he has worked in both audio and lightening for various performances. Nate also volunteers on the audio and visual team at Oak Hill Baptist. He received his BBA degree from UGA in May 2020. We are delighted to have him as part of MSP!



CARLA CLOUD (Stage Manager) last appeared as Marjorie Baverstock in *The Musical Comedy Murders of 1940*, Alice Bordin in *The Tin Woman* and Marlafaye Mosley in the *The Savannah Sipping Society*. Originally from the Atlanta area, she has spent most of her adult life just over the state line in South Carolina, but has been back in this area since 2019. Having appeared on many different stages over the last 40 years, her two most favorite roles are Hilda in *Hilda's Yard* and Alice in *The Tin Woman*. In addition to theater, Carla has experience in all areas of media including film, TV, and VO.

She was the lead female in the faith-based film, "Waiting for Butterflies" and most recently played a supporting role in the upcoming movie, "How Not to Date." 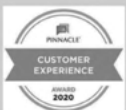
