

# A Message from the Director

It's 1942. War is raging in two world theaters. But the theaters of Broadway are more concerned with the unsolved case of the Broadway slasher who killed three chorus girls two years ago. These are the inspiring events of John Bishops *The Musical Comedy Murders of 1940*. And three of my favorite theatrical elements when choosing a play to direct. A comedy. A murder mystery. And a period piece. All rolled into one. What more could you ask for?

The play enjoyed a long and critically hailed run both on and Off-Broadway when it premiered in 1987. But thirty five years later it still holds up by poking antic fun at the more ridiculous aspects of "show biz" and the corny thrillers of Hollywood's heyday. The Village Voice said, "Bishop gives us a nakedly silly and relentlessly convoluted murder-mystery plot with twist piled on twist till you have to give way and start laughing at the silliness."

I couldn't agree more. And I hope you do as well. Enjoy!
